

Activities of VOICE Trust from 1985 to 2021

1985	Registration of VOICE Trust as a non-profit Social Service & Social Action Voluntary Organization (NGO– Non Governmental Organization) for involving in economic – social - educational schemes for the integrated empowerment of the economically - socially - educationally disadvantaged people irrespective of creed, caste, gender, language, race, region or any other discrimination whatsoever.
1986	Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) approval obtained from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India. Continues to be valid for the past 30 years. We submit Reports to Home Ministry yearly.

1989 to 1994	White Saree System which exploited Widows in Murungai and surrounding Villages was fought fiercely by Mrs. A. Jecinta, now the Managing Trustee of VOICE Trust. She organized first the women and then men and achieved wearing of colour sarees by widows to stop stigma of doom. On November 14 1994, organized a Child Rights Rally by 5000 Children in Town Hall, Trichy addressed by Nobel Laureate Kailash Satyarthi, IPS Thilagavathy and J. Paul Baskar of Peace Trust.



COVID Relief Programs for 352 Families affected by COVID – 19 lockdown in Tamil Nadu, India with supports from BOISE Tamil Sangam, Idaho, USA.

It was an important day for Social Workers in the State of Tamil Nadu, India, when Thiurmigu Gowri and Board Members of BOISE Tamil Sangam, Idaho, USA, came forward to provide relief for people of 22 villages in Irungalur – Purathakudi – Ayakudi areas in Tiruchirappalli District, State of Tamil Nadu, India, affected and afflicted by COVID – 19 lockdown from mid march 2020.

It was great of All in BOISE Tamil Sangam to actualize their social concern with people of Tamil Nadu afflicted by Corona Virus Pandemic by providing relief.

VOICE Team selected villages around Irangalur in Manachanallur Block and chose 300 most deserving families like daily wage earning laborers, Differently Abled Persons and Irular Tribals. Each family was allotted 5 Kilos rice, 1 kilo wheat, 1 kilo red gram, 100 grams each of Chilly-Corriander-Sambar Powder, 1 litre oil, soap, Sanitary Napkin, salt, 1 kilo sugar, 100 grams of tea powder, 10 kilo bag was stitched with logos of BOISE and VOICE. Goods were transported by trucks. Children of Friendship Children's Home packed the goods in bags.

- On May 7, 2020, Inspector Madan from Samayapuram Police Station, National College Professors Dr. Gunaseelan and Dr. Prasanna Balaji, Panchayat President Mr. Vincent distributed relief goods to 100 families of 8 villages around Irangalur. Arun Rajesh-Victoria-Kavitha from VOICE coordinated. Joe-Sudakar were the Volunteers.
- On May 8, 2020, Post Graduate Teacher Mr. L. Lourde Xavier from Government Higher secondary school distributed relief goods to 95 families of 4 villages around Purathakudi. Same VOICE Team Coordinated
- On May 9, 2020, Fr. R. Vincent Ferrar and Ayakudi Panchayat President distributed relief foods to 157 families in 10 villages. VOICE Administrator Preethi joined Victoria and Kavitha in the distribution.

Development Programs with Disabled (DPD) Allround Empowerments of Differently Abled Persons

Some in VOICE Trust involved in World Disabled Day in 1983 when it was introduced for first time. They organized a Fund Raising Program with violin Maestro Kunnakudi Vaithianathan and Musician Valayapatti Jayaraman. They went to 150 Centres in 6 Districts of Tamil Nadu and organized Awareness Programs in Empathy by Society with the Differently Abled Persons, screened film shows, enacted branches, organized cultural programs and disbursed cash aids for the physically disabled and mentally Challenged Persons.

In 1998, “Who is the cause” the street Theatre continued the people that disability is not punishment from the gods or cause to the families but only due to lack of nutritious food – potable water – hygiene – sanitation and basic needs for a healthy life. Since, society failed to provide the basic needs, community based rehabilitation must be accepted. Initially only 105 Disabled Children were identified. But because of VOICE Team’s awareness programs 241 Disabled Children, 324 Disabled Adults and 287 Mentally ill Persons got enrolled.

Home based therapy, Medical Treatments, Aids and Appliances, Inclusive Education, Skills Trainings were furthered. Identification Card and other Government Schemes were also furthered.

In 2010, District Differently Abled Welfare Office nominated VOICE Trust for Guide Scheme in Mannachanallur Block with help of 40 Differently Abled Staff.

In 2013, Tamil Nadu Corporation for Development of Women (Mahalir Thittam - Thiruchirappalli) nominated VOICE Trust as BDMRFA (Block Disability Mitigation and Rehabilitation Facilitating Agency) for Mannachanallur and Thottiam Blocks.

In 2018, 5 more Blocks (Lalgudi – Pullambhadi – Thriuverambur – Vaiyampatti - Uppiliapuram) given for Trainings to CDB under TNSRLM (Tamil Nadu State Rural Livelihood Mission)

So far 9222 Differently Abled Persons identified and following activities continued.

Empower Differently Abled kids in Tamil Nadu

Our outreach efforts pay off, if not yet in the way we'd hoped

19.07.2020

In this Pandemic Situation, we had a devastating effect on Tamil Nadu. Many farmers, roadside vendors, roadside dwellers, beggars, and daily-wage workers have seen their income evaporate, and have been struggling to survive.

Luckily, several generous grants received with the assistance of [Friends of the Third World](#), awesome response from our GlobalGiving supporters, and the aid of our devoted and heroic volunteers have made it possible for us to provide rice



and groceries to feed 900 families in need for a month, and support from local partners further enabled us to provide at least a biscuit and often a hot meal to many more who would have otherwise have had nothing to eat for the day.

For the differently-abled and their families, this time has been especially trying, since their options were already severely limited. Because of our outreach efforts to identify these families, our relief efforts were able to include **emergency rations for the households of 208 differently-abled people** in Siruganur, C.R. Palayam, Tirupattur, M.R. Palayam, Sanamangalam, Sridevimangalam, and Maniyakurichi.

Our own COVID hero continues to transform lives

Despite having herself contracted COVID-19, Mrs. Victoria, our coordinator of activities for the People with Disabilities (PwD), has continued to be dedicated to improving their lives throughout the pandemic. Last month, she took seven mentally challenged individuals to hospital for treatment, and she has begun training PwD in income-generating activities like candle making and threadwork design. She was also the chief guest at an event organized to share information about how PwD can collect the government-related benefits available to them.



Mr. Donald was stricken by polio when he was 4 and his right leg was permanently affected. He used a walking stick to attend school and was able to complete his 12th standard in. But was not able to study further due to the circumstances in his family's straitened circumstances and his difficulty using public transport. His parents were worried about whether he would ever be able to support himself.

Through the Mobility India Scheme, Mrs. Victoria was able to get him an artificial leg, and gave him the assistance he needed to complete a Computer Science course in Open University. Today, he works in a computer centre in Thillai Nagar and earns enough to not only support himself but help his parents and sister. Donations from Friends of Third World have helped fund Victoria's work, and we are deeply grateful for your support.

In 1994 Eco Farming Expert Nammalwar guided VOICE Trust to turn from Broiler Poultry Farming to Ecological Agriculture. In 1995, self Employee Schemes in Agriculture and Agrobased Enterprises with help from Misereor

VOICE Trust got introduced to LEISA (Low External Input Sustainable Agriculture) in 1997 by Mr.Oswald Quintal, Director, Kudumbam, In 1997, Thirumigu N.Krishnasamy to IPM (Integrated Pest Management Centre) of Government of India and Mr.Kader Ibrahim – the then Assistant Director of Agriculture of Government of Tamil Nadu and to IFS (Integrated Farming Systems) in 1996 by AME (Agriculture, Man, Ecology) Team of Mr.A.Daniel Anand Raj, Mrs.A.Kamila, and 18 Agri Graduates like Mayakannan and Radhakrishnan.

From 1999 TOT (Training of Trainers) in IFS for Sustainable Livelihood was organized in collaboration with IGSSS (Indo Global Social Service Society) with support from G.Nammalwar – Eco Farming Expert, Mr.P.Venkatesan – the then Joint Director of Agriculture, Mr.P.Palaniappan – the then Deputy Director of Agriculture and Agriculture – Agrobased Enterprises Experts from Government and other Organizations. 

**Preparation for Seeds, Tree Seedlings, Organic Inputs for 150 Farmers in 5 Villages
in Tiruchirappalli District, State of Tamil Nadu, India
with help from Salvatorian Relief Action, Belgium**

Some in VOICE trust are associated with Salvatorian Relief Action from Belgium from 1977. It was indeed a privilege to get help from Salvatoriaanse for Purchase of Cows for Friendship Children's Home in 2013. Cows are helping 45 parentless and other disadvantaged Children for past 9 years.

Second help came from Salvatorian Relief Action in 2015 for Return to normalcy of 120 Mentally ill Persons. Besides medical treatment, the Mentally ill Persons were also given livelihood supports like Organic Farming Inputs and Livelihood supports with Goats. Because of this help from Salvatoriaanse the Mentally ill Persons are now considered valuable with regular income generations.

Thrid help from Salvatorian Relief Action came in December 2020. But, due to COVID lockdowns, Farmers can not be gathered in groups and hence activities under Project Number 20/052 have been extended to 2021 – 2022 financial year.

Special Note: Activities have begun in 2021 and will be completed by or before March 2022 for the benefit of 150 resource poor farmers from 5 Villages

In 1998, Department of Environment, Government of Tamil Nadu, nominated VOICE Trust as the Environment Coordinator for Eco Clubs in Schools of Trichy District. 24th year in this honorary service.

The first Eco Club was started on 11.11.1998 at Corporation Middle School at Tiruvanaikoil in the presence of the then Director of Environment Dr.T.Sekar IFS., Mr.R.Krishnamoorthy – Chief Educational Officer, Mr.P.Muthuveeran – Commissioner of Trichy City Corporation.

90 Schools from Grand Anaicut to Musiri – Thiraiyur included in the first year. Classes for students on Personal Hygiene, Driver for cleanliness inside the school and around school campus, Growing of Trees – Herbals – Vegetables and Campaigns for Green Environment were organized by VOICE Trust.

In 2001, National Green Corps (NGC) were introduced by Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India and Green School Program was furthered with help of Centre for Society and Environment, New Delhi

In 2005, Trichy District got 250 NGC Schools and 359 Eco Clubs with 24360 Students in 609 Schools. VOICE Trust took direct responsibility for Lalgudi Educational District and extended coordination for Trichy - Manaparai – Musiri Educational Districts.

‘One Grain-One Day’ for a strong gen-next

IN a bid to help malnourished children get nutrient-rich diet, a city-based NGO, Voice Trust, has come up with a special initiative of adopting one village a week and distributing food prepared using grains and pulses to the children. As many as 100 children in Edhumalai were beneficiaries in the first week of the initiative which began on June 7.

Voice Trust has already been working for the development of rural people and teaching agriculture activities to the younger generation.

Speaking about its ‘One Grain-One Day’ initiative, A Gregory, project director, said, “Following the implementation of lockdown, many children could not get nutritious meals as all schools remained closed. This left many children in rural areas with no access to protein-rich meals, thereby affecting their growth and health. So, we came up with the special initiative of providing one variety a day for children for a week.” This also emphasises that parents take up the traditional menu with more nutrients in the diet, he added.

Under the initiative, the NGO will be adopting a village for five days and distributing millets and pulses as snacks in the evening hours. It distributes chickpeas, green gram, black gram and black peas on a daily basis. The initiative will cover CR Palayam and later, Siruganur.

Kavitha, organiser, said, “We mix grains with jaggery and make it like sweet stew or other recipes which children like. We are distributing cooked grains to nearly 100 children in Edhumalai and explain the details about nutritious content in each of them. We take the BMI for 10 children and will once again check it at the end of the week to show the parents how much of growth and positive change such foods give to children.”
